To complete online training the link is:

You will need to create an account in order to access these modules.

Please make sure that you register the fact that you belong to the Diocese of Southwell and Nottingham when you create your account, and add the full name of the Church and where it is and then we can check that you have completed it and let you or your Parish Safeguarding Coordinator know if necessary. You can also print off your own certificates to show to your Parish Safeguarding Coordinator as proof that you have done the course.

C0 – Safeguarding Basic Awareness

It is a **requirement** that everyone attending the C1 module completes the C0 Basic Introduction first. Your Parish Safeguarding Coordinator may be able to facilitate this for you in your own church or you can complete it online.

Note re- training for PCC members - The C0 is the **minimum** training required for everyone on your PCC. If you have any additional responsibilities such as work with children or adults, prayer ministry etc. Or are Safeguarding coordinator or lead for the PCC, or Church Warden then you also need to do C1 and possibly C2 as well.

It is best practice to work towards everyone on the PCC completing C1 as well.#

C1 online

An online version of the C1 course is also available and can be accessed through the Training Portal link above.
