Remember

Safeguarding is everybody's responsibility; it's not for you to investigate or decide whether abuse has taken place.

If you are concerned about the welfare of a child, young person or adult at risk talk to your Parish Safeguarding Coordinator, your incumbent or the Diocesan Safeguarding Adviser.

Abuse can be perpetrated or caused by anyone at any time.

If you have concerns:

Do:

Ensure the immediate health and safety of the person – dial 999 in an emergency

Listen and reassure

Take all concerns seriously

Seek advice

Only tell those who need to know

If you have concerns:

Do not:

Promise confidentiality

Ignore information or concerns regardless of who the person being spoken about is

Place yourself at risk of abuse or harm
