

## Families Worker (Maternity Cover)

#### **Details**

Part-time maternity cover required for our Families Discipleship Worker. The post is 15h / week, but if the applicant was sufficiently experienced to take on the role of Parish Safeguarding Co-ordinator, then we'd pay for an extra 3.5h / week for that.

The role begins at Easter 2024, and we anticipate it continuing until the end of 2024. Pay is at £14.15 per hour, plus matched pension contributions, and with entitlement to annual leave.

## Responsibilities

Principal responsibilities include:

- Organising and running (2x per month) our Sunday morning work with primary-aged children.
- Organising and running our Thursday evening activities for secondaryaged children.
- Recruiting and managing volunteers to make sure that both groups can run every week during termtime.

Specific responsibilities, in partnership with the Incumbent, include:

- Supporting and communicating with families involved in the life of the church
- Devising / resourcing schemes of work for the Sunday morning groups.

General responsibilities:

- Committing to praying for the church family and the leadership and mission of the church in private devotional time, and the weekly staff meeting
- Leading by example in sharing the gospel one to one with non-Christian friends and neighbours
- Sharing with other staff and lay people in providing pastoral care, particularly for those in acute need or who serve in leadership roles
- Attending PCC meetings as needed, and relevant diocesan events
- Helping with other activities for children and families, many of which are run by our Children & Families Outreach Worker.
